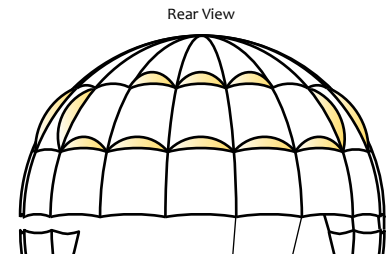


# Parafauna.co.uk – Parasail : Mk III

This is the parafauna mk3 version parasail.



It consists of around 64 panels excluding the skirts but these can be reduced to 41 if you consolidate some of the panelling that aren't side or rear vents. This can be done by sticking together some of the panel templates.

## Material:

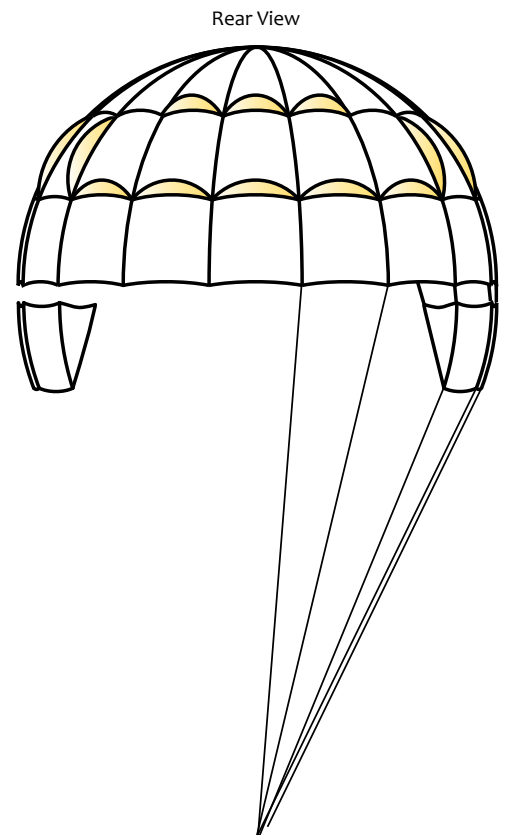
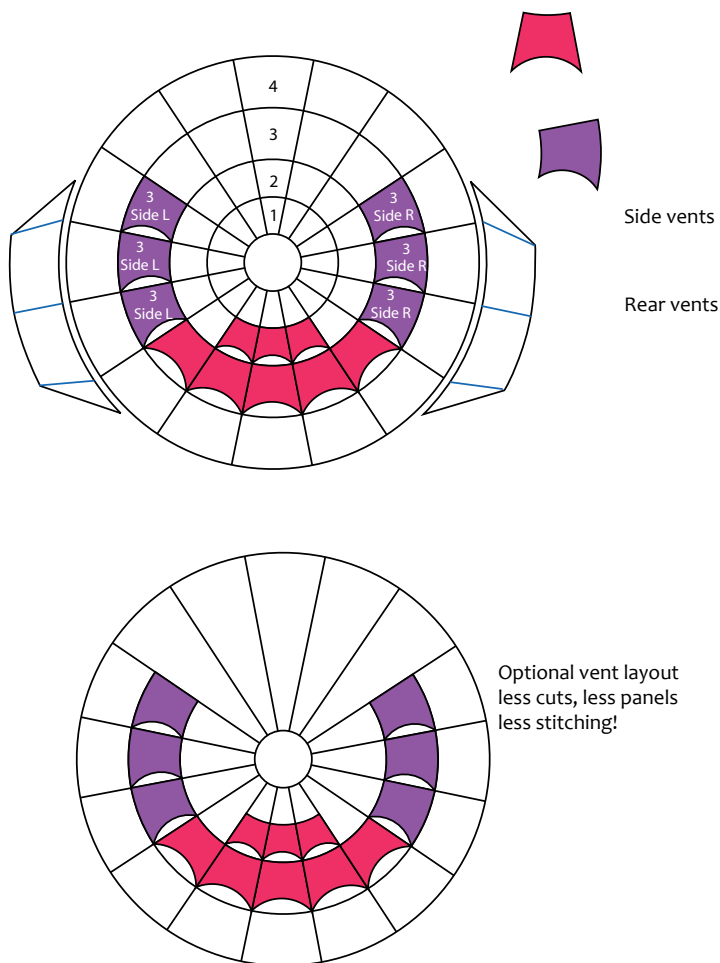
First choice would be a lightweight, proofed, rip-stop nylon.

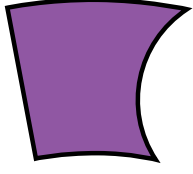
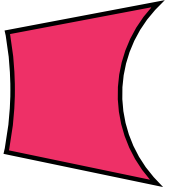
## Note:

There is a left and right side for the Panel 3 side vents. Cut on one side for the right vents, turn the template over and cut the Left ones. This is the only panel that is side specific.

## Seam allowance: 6mm

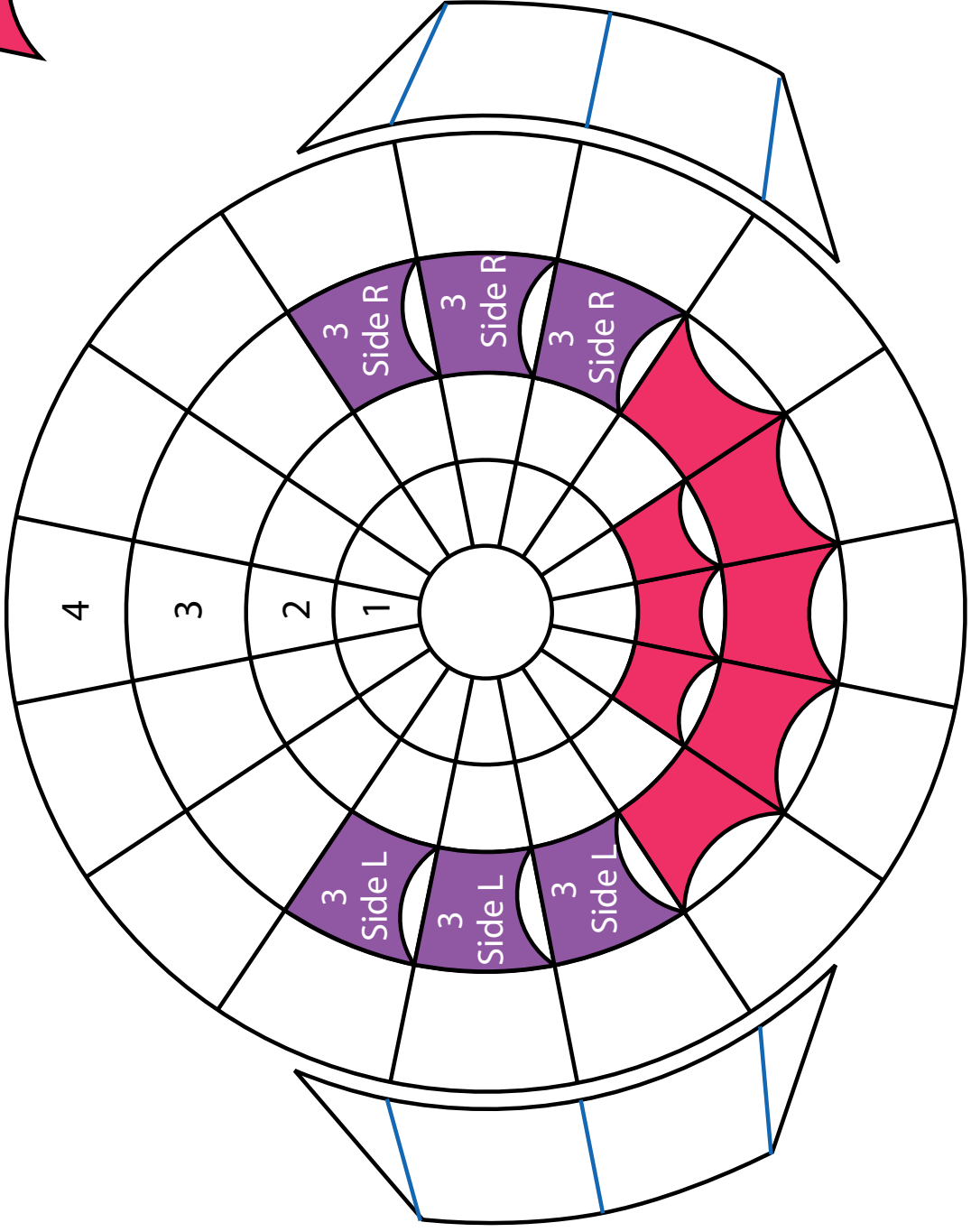
The original panel is show inside the seam allowance. That is what you are stitching to.

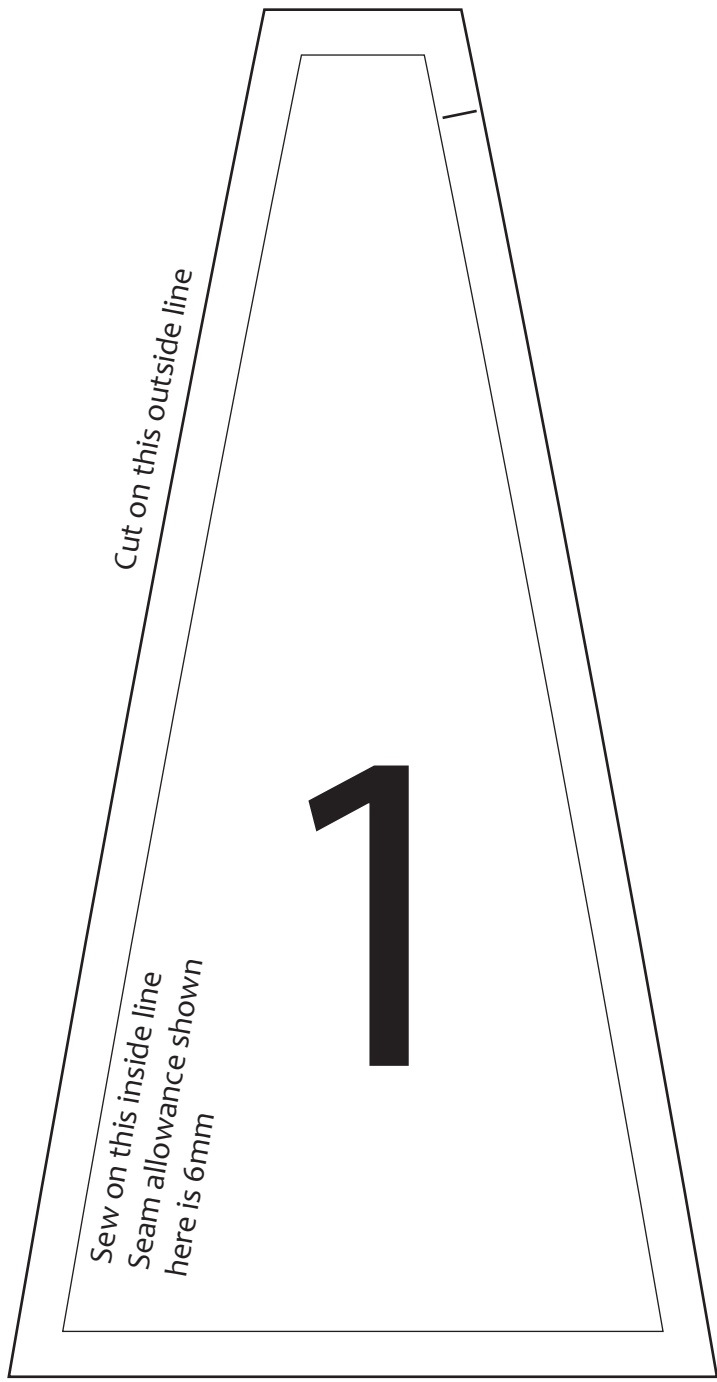




Side vents
